

Subject Eliminating authority and funding for a public option

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Overview

H.F. 27 repeals the commissioner of commerce's authority to apply to the federal government for a waiver to establish a public option in the state and then implement the public option upon receipt of the waiver. The bill also eliminates the \$21,000,000 appropriation from the health care access fund (HCAF) that would be available to implement a public option, provided the state received a waiver.
