Overview

The Department of Children, Youth, and Families administers the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Outreach Program, which is a competitive grant program to inform low-income households about the availability, eligibility requirements, application process, and benefits of the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). SNAP increases the food purchasing power of lowincome households by providing a monthly allotment to purchase food and food products in approved stores.

This bill appropriates \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year of the 2026-2027 biennium to the commissioner of children, youth, and families for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Outreach Program.
